COMMUNITY

The goal of a COMMUNITY event is to REACH as many students as possible, involve them in the event's activities & bring them into a welcoming and open community of students following Jesus. These nights also give our current students the opportunity to easily invite a friend or two!

ELEMENT CAFE is open to all Middle School students on Tuesdays & Thursdays from 3:00-5:30 PM. Element Cafe DOES NOT cost anything to enter, though we always appreciate a \$1 donation at the door. Drinks & snacks are only 50 cents! Element Cafe takes place in the youth area of Trinity UMC & is a great and safe space for students to relax, do homework, play in our gym & game room, eat snacks & hang out with friends & our youth staff.

REACH NIGHT is the BEST night of the month, typically on the last Sunday of each month, to REACH OUT and invite a friend to Element. REACH Nights are fun-filled nights to become comfortable with the youth ministry environment. These nights include the Annual Tailgate Party, Pumpkinfest, The Element Dodgeball Tournament, Spotlight and more! 6-8PM.



CROWD

CROWD programs are designed to encourage students to invite their friends and to interact with others. These events are laid back and accessible for any students! Students involved in crowd programs are given a great chance to better connect with friends and staff alike, allowing for them to feel more a part of our ministry.

SUNDAY NIGHT LIVE! SNL is typically held on the first three Sundays of each month from 6:00-7:00 PM. These nights are filled with worship, dinner, videos, skits & a message from our staff or a guest speaker. Many of our students participate in leading SNL, making this a great opportunity to bring a friend to church for this incredible one hour service.

Following SNL, we will have a PLUS portion of the night that will allow students to hangout with & connect to other students, our youth team & volunteers from 7:00-8:00 PM. These events can include activities on or off campus. Times & locations will be updated at the start of each month in our weekly email, our social media & website.

FAN CLUB

Fan Club is an 'at random' program, led by Rhys Ferguson our community director, in which "ELEMENT" will come to a local middle or high school school event to celebrate and cheer on our students in style (we're talking highlighter yellow shirts)! CONGREGATION

CONGREGATION programs are aimed towards those students who are already comfortable at church. These students range from those who attend church with their families to those who come on their own, all seeking to begin studying the Bible.

ELEMENT AM is an environment of fun, fellowship and growth. Classes are divided into 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th/10th and 11th/12th grade groups. We have a seven-year cycle curriculum, so students experience a well-rounded study of the Bible and theology. Each class has discussion, games and a time to study scripture. Classes are on Sunday mornings from 9:45–10:30 AM. Good News! There are donuts, juice and coffee too.



COMMITTED

COMMITTED programs are for students who are seeking a deeper relationship with Christ, want to give back to the church and develop their leadership skills. These programs will help students in all of these areas, with individual support and encouragement in their growth from our staff.

FUSION Groups are offered for each grade and broken out by guys and girls. Groups have the freedom to meet whenever and wherever! Each group is led by trained, caring adult leaders who aim to lead their groups throughout all their years at Element. We have a seven-year rotation of what the students study, based on interests, struggles and questions they may have about faith and the Bible.

Our hope is that students will grow in their faith just as they grow in stature. Students may join a FUSION group any time throughout the year and they are open to everyone (it's not a 'Members Only' club).

ELEMENTOR is a mentoring ministry where older students will help mentor younger students. We challenge our mentors to support their mentee through weekly prayer, presence, gifts, service and witness. ELEMENTOR will be launching October of 2021.

CORE

CORE programs are aimed towards students who are actively seeking to grow deeper in their faith and be leaders in the ministry. Many of the core programs are organized and led by students with little, if any, direction or follow-up from adult leadership.

THE JOURNEY is a program designed for students who are ready to take their spiritual journey to a deeper level. The program is customized for each student to study five Biblical principles: worship, service, evangelism, fellowship and discipleship. Students are challenged to complete a task associated with each principle. They are given guidelines but are encouraged to come up with their own task based on their talents or passion. Also, The Journey challenges students to read a book and complete a devotional during the year. The ultimate goal of The Journey is to prepare students to be servants of Christ once they graduate from high school and leave the spiritual support of their families and youth minister. The Journey will be launching in October of 2021.

STUDENT LEADERSHIP TEAM is for students who are ready and willing to give back to the student ministry, specifically on Sunday nights. Students are not nominated or elected to the leadership team. Anyone is welcome to join. Roles include our Welcome Team, Tech Team and Community/Follow Up Team. Students will meet once a month with Robert and other staff both to learn, give feedback and be equipped to serve. To join, contact Robert and become a student leader!

HOW-YOU-CAN-SERVE

ONCE A MONTH COMMITMENT:

- Element AM Teacher, Sundays 9:30-10:30 AM

10 per-grade level teachers willing to commit to a monthly rotation during the school year. A co-teacher and/or staff member is partnered with you, as well as supplies and curriculum.

- A Journey Guide

14 adults that are willing to check in with students on "the Journey" (our personal discipleship toolkit) roughly once a month to see about their progress and offer words of encouragement. Commitment time is two hours a month.

WEEKLY (with flexibility):

-FUSION GROUP BIBLE STUDY SMALL GROUP LEADER

Adult Leaders for by grade/by gender small groups that meet weekly throughout the school year. The commitment is roughly one hour a week. At least one co-teacher and/or staff member is partnered with you, as well as supplies and curriculum.

ELEMENT SUNDAY NIGHTS Adult Volunteer.

Sundays 5:45-8:00 PM.

30+ adult volunteers to hang out, serve meals to, encourage and talk with students on Sunday nights during the school year.

ELEMENT CAFE MENTOR.

Tuesdays and/or Thursdays. Various Roles & Shifts.

Element Cafe is one of the most important ministries at Element, that seeks to provide students with a safe haven through a Christian environment after school on Tuesdays and Thursdays. We have a lot of different roles and shifts available. Shift 1 - 3:00-4:15 and Shift 2 - 4:15-5:30. In these shifts you'll have the opportunity to work at the front desk, serve at the concession stand, play games in the gym, or be a front desk monitor.
